

READING FOR SOPHOMORE CADETS – dated 18 January 2011

All sophomore cadets will find an appropriate book they find interesting. This book must be brought to JROTC every day along with their reading journal (notebook for writing about their book). If the cadet has a question of its appropriateness, the cadet must receive approval from either the cadet leadership or Instructor.

If the book is not brought to class, the following corrective actions will occur:

- 1st offense = -10 employability and verbally counseled
- 2nd offense = -20 employability, Infraction Report, and call to parents
- 3rd offense = -30 employability, a referral, and call to parents

When directed for the first fifteen (15) minutes, all cadets will read their book. This will be followed by writing in their journals. Every entry must include, at a minimum, the following:

- Date
- Pages Read (e.g. pg 12-17),
 - A summary paragraph (3-5 sentences) covering what they read.

Journals will be graded biweekly on the following scale:

- Correct number of entries (5 pts)
- Standard information (date/pages read) (5 pts)
- Paragraph summary (3-5 sentences) (10 pts)

If a cadet reads an entire book, they will continue with a new book
