



## Florida State JROTC Marksmanship State Qualifying Area 5 Competition

Area 5 Postal matches have been executed over the past couple years to determine the teams competing in the shoulder-to-shoulder. With the implementation of the Florida State JROTC Marksmanship competition this year, there will be **NO POSTALS** fired; rather the shoulder-to-shoulder will be the prelude to the state championship, per the 6<sup>th</sup> Brigade State JROTC Marksmanship State Meet MOI, to determine the teams that will participate in the Florida State Championship competition at Island Coast HS in Cape Coral, Florida on 28 April 2012.

**LOCATION:** Sarasota Military Academy, 801 N. Orange Ave, Sarasota, Florida 34236

**DATE:** March 2-3, 2012.

**EQUIPMENT CLASSES:** Competition is open to Sporter ONLY.

**RULES:** All conditions not specified herein will be governed by ***CMP 2010-2012 National Standard Three Position Air Rifle Rules, 8<sup>th</sup> Edition, 1 September 2010.***

**TEAMS:** All schools may enter ten (10) cadets (all will receive the competition ribbon). Team scores will consist of the sum of the top four (4) cadets' scores unless designated by the coach differently. **All cadets must be enrolled and eligible by the FHSAA standards.**

**TIME SCHEDULE:** Two relays Friday and 6 relays on Saturday, if needed. The last required relays on Saturday will be followed by a "Finals" and then the Awards presentations.

**FRIDAY:** Relay 1 (1500-1630), Relay 2 (1630-1800)

**SATURDAY:** Relay 3 (0830-1000), Relay 4 (1000-1130), Relay 5 (1130-1300),  
Relay 6 (1300-1430), Relay 7 (1430-1600), Relay 8 (1600-1730).

**COURSE OF FIRE:** Ten (10) shots in each of the three (3) positions – prone, standing and kneeling, in sequence, will be fired by each competitor. Participants will be given a Special Sighting Period of 15 minutes shooting 3 shots in each of the 2 sighter bulls. Cadets will be given 15 minutes for their 10 record shots in Prone however; a cadet may take more sighter shots in their sighter bulls prior to any record shots within the 15 minutes allotted for the Prone position. Furthermore, cadets may take sighter shots in their Standing and Kneeling positions but they must be done prior to any record shots and within the allotted time for that position. Times allowed in each position are: Prone-15 minutes, Standing-20 minutes, Kneeling-15 minutes.

**FINALS:** We will conduct a "Finals" immediately after the \*final relay and once all scores are confirmed and cadets identified for the finals. The top ten (10) cadets, no more than two (2) per school, will compete in a 10 Shot Standing Finals. They will be positioned on firing points IAW their score from the 3x10. Once identified and called to the line, they will have a three (3) minutes preparation period followed by a five (5) minute sighting period. Each competitor will then be given commands to "load" and "start", to complete a single shot in 75 seconds, then given the command "stop." A "preliminary" score will be given and all shooters will be told in sequence on the firing line. Then we will move on to the next competition shot, etc until all 10 shots have been fired. Following the last shot and line made "safe" we will pull targets and check target for score confirmation.



**DISTANCE:** Ten (10) meters/thirty three (33) feet will be the distance between the face of the targets and the firing line.

**RIFLES:** Air rifles authorized are the following Sporter Air Rifles: AirForce Air Guns Edge, Crossman Challenger CH2000 (CO<sub>2</sub>) and CH2009 (CO<sub>2</sub> or compressed air), Daisy Model #753, 853, 953, 853CM (pneumatic), Daisy 887/888 (CO<sub>2</sub>), Daisy XSV40 Valiant (compressed air), and Air Arms T-200 (compressed air) with a non-adjustable cheek-piece and butt-plate. Daisy 887/888 rifles may have 2010 model replacement stocks. 853. All these rifles are in compliance with the National Standard Three-Position Air Rifle Rules 2010-2012, 8<sup>th</sup> Edition, 1 September 2010.

**TARGETS and SCORING:** ORION Scoring System Targets will be provided. Target labels are not required; however, the shooter's name and target position must be bubbled in prior to posting targets on target stand. Only one (1) shot is fired on each record bull.

Targets will be scored using the ORION Scoring System. Team tie scores will be broken by same method of individual ties per the National Standard Rules (inner 10s, then highest score in kneeling).

**OPTIONAL CLOTHING:** Shooting gloves only are permitted. Shooting jackets, pants and boots are not allowed.

**QUALIFYING TEAMS:** The top three (3) teams from Area 5 will earn a spot in the Florida State Championship competition at Island Coast HS, Cape Coral, Florida on 28 April 2012. The entry fee to the state championships is \$50; make checks payable to HQ 6<sup>th</sup> Brigade, USACC. If a team declines the invitation, it will be offered to the next highest scoring team.

**AWARDS:** All cadets must be present for the awards ceremony to receive awards. All participating cadets will receive a match ribbon for the "Area 5 District Match." Additionally, each of the four shooting team members of the First and Second place teams will receive Medallions. Individual awards for top three (3) scores and High score in each position will receive awards. Lastly, of the top 10 cadets shooting in the finals, the top five (5) will receive a Medallion (1-Gold, 1-Silver and 3-Bronze).

As in the past, a cadet can only receive a maximum of 2 total individual awards (1-high score, 1-position).

**ENTRY FEES:** As last year, the cost is \$40 per team (4 competitors); add \$2.50 for each additional competitor. Entry fees may be paid in advance or day of competition.
