



Florida State Junior Olympic State Qualifying Competition

LOCATION: Sarasota Military Academy, Sarasota, Florida 34236

DATE: April 21+22, 2012.

SPONSOR: Sarasota Military Academy Rifle Team.

EVENTS: Individual and Team 3 x 20. Twenty (20) shots in each of the three (3) positions – prone, standing and kneeling, in sequence, will be fired by each competitor. Two (2) targets will be used for each position. Participants may take as many sighting shots as necessary at either or both of the sighting bulls in the center (guard ring) of the **first target** sheet. Sighting shots are only permitted on the first target (see Rules 7.3). All sighting shots must be taken before any shot for record is fired. Times allowed: Preparation-10 minutes, Prone-30 minutes, Changeover-5 minutes, Standing-40 minutes, Changeover-5 minutes, Kneeling-30 minutes which includes sighting shots.

TIME SCHEDULE:

SATURDAY: Relay 1 (11:00am–1:30pm), Relay 2 (1:30pm – 4:00pm), Relay 3 (4:00pm-6:30pm).

SUNDAY: Relay 4 (11:00am–1:30pm), Relay 5 (1:30pm – 4:00pm), Relay 6 (4:00pm-6:30pm).

EQUIPMENT CLASSES: Competition is open to both Sporter and Precision classes.

COMPETITION OPEN TO: All high school aged competitors of a school, club, JROTC or other similar organization of the state of Florida (see Rules 3.1, 3.2).

RULES: All conditions not specified herein will be governed by **CMP 2010-2012 National Standard Three Position Air Rifle Rules, 8th Edition, 1 September 2010**.

SCORING: Targets will be mailed and scored at the CMP Orion Scoring System and results will be posted on the CMP website.

AWARDS: CMP EIC Awards/Points will be issued to top shooters from all the state championships combined. The CMP will issue medals to the top shooters for the state in both Sporter and Precision categories. Additionally, the Civilian Marksmanship Program, in coordination with USA Shooting will provide special awards for the top JROTC shooters in each State Qualifying Competition for the National Junior Olympic Three-Position Air Rifle Championship. The CMP JROTC special awards program is part of a cooperative agreement between the military cadet commands and the CMP to promote marksmanship activities and competitions among JROTC cadets.
