

Rules for reworking missed test questions in Captain Callihan's Algebra class:

1. Corrections must be on a separate sheet of paper with proper heading and turned in with the old test.
2. Rewrite each problem.
3. Show every step of the solution or answer.
4. Change all subtraction to adding the opposite.
5. Bonus questions are eligible for re-work.
6. Answers must be correct.
7. True/False, fill-in-the blank, and multiple choice questions can be reworked by rewriting the question and providing a written explanation (in complete, grammatically correct sentences) of why the right answer is correct.
*example: T or F: The absolute value of a number is always positive.
"The answer is False, because the absolute value of zero is zero, and zero is neither positive or negative, so all absolute values are not positive. A true statement on this matter would be that the absolute value of a number is never negative."*
8. No re-work for problems that received part credit the first time.
9. No re-work credit if rules are not followed.
