

PTCC Meeting December 14, 2010

The meeting was called to order by president Elke Olree at 6:00 pm.

To date 2096 wreathes were purchased with a profit for the school of \$870.00. The headstones that did not have a wreath placed on them were given a flag instead in order to decorate each head stone. The goal for next year is to keep the program active all year and be able to place a wreath on each head stone.

The cell phone and ink cartridge recycle fundraiser has netted \$82.00. We received various amounts depending on the type of phone. We are looking for someone to take over this fundraiser.

The faculty Christmas party is coming up. The PTCC Board has approved \$100.00 towards this function.

In order to assure our veterans on staff are recognized the PTCC Board has decided a plaque in the office with a nameplate for each would be appropriate. The Board asked for and received \$500.00 to accomplish this goal.

Upcoming events include Memorial Day and Graduation. Graduation is scheduled for May 26. These events will be discussed further at the next meeting.

Attendance at PTCC Meeting has been low. Ideas to increase this include: changed the time of the meeting to the morning, offering the cadets an Eagle card for attendance, or announcing it in the Eagle Preview. A decision was made to keep the evening meeting and not meet in the morning.

A few volunteers are needed in various positions. Someone to oversee collection and distribution of uniform items that are not issued is needed. The carpool list needs a

volunteer to start it over the summer and continuously update it throughout the year. Also someone is needed to oversee the care packages and communication with SMA soldiers.

The PTCC often is asked to financially assist SMA cadets and their families. There is a need for someone to start up and over see such a program if it is deemed necessary. The Board sees there is a need but agrees there is potential for someone to take advantage of such a program. The need for a volunteer to head the Benevolent Fund was presented but no one volunteered. PTCC will continue to discuss this in the future.

Future goals for the PTCC include: nominees for the Board- which will be received in time for the March meeting, future fundraising- a silent auction, cook off, or "Taste of SMA", and the possibility of a Homecoming weekend- including a dance, pep rally, and demonstrations by the various teams.
